





What advantages to flourishing mental health?

Complete mental health

Optimal mental health "Flourishing"

No mental disorder

Better social, economic, health functioning.... (Keyes, 2002, Keyes & Grzywacz, 2005). Diminished risks for developing a mental disorder (Keyes, Dhingra, & Simoes, 2010) and for suicide in post secondary students (Keyes, Eisenberg, Perry et al., 2012). Lessened probability of all cause mortality (Keyes & Simoes, 2012)

Improve the population's mental health: reconciling two logics





What evidence to support the promotion of mental health?

Most mental health promotion interventions produce the double effect of reducing risks for mental health problems and increasing mental health and its protecting

factors (Hosman & Jané-Llopis, 1999; Barry, 2007; IUHPE, 2005, Herrman & Jané-Llopis, 2012; Keyes, Dhingra, & Simoes, 2010; Keyes. Eisenberg, Perry *et al., 2012).*

Potential to improve social, health and economic functioning during the entire life trajectory (Herrman, Saxena, & Moodie, 2005; IUHPE, 2005; Herrman & Jané-Llopis, 2012; Friedli, 2009).




Translation: Letters from the words with a letter cut out are used to make up the word "santé publique" or public health.

Challenges for public health


- Integrate mental health promotion into already existing programs.
 - Develop interventions dedicated to promoting mental health
 - Throughout the life course
 - On multiple factors
 - Using numerous strategies
 - With the community's participation.
- Collaborate with and support other sectors (HPP-FMH / MHIA — healthy public policies favouring mental health, mental health impact assessment).
- Support the public health workforce (competencies, resources, institutional and political support).
