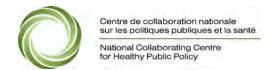

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
#### Day One

#### Global Status Report on HiAP

- ✓ Different countries are in stages
- ✓ Role of Governance is critical
- ✓ There is no one way of implementing HiAP
- ✓ Adapting the framework is important
- ✓ SDGs are very important to support HiAP approach

#### Workshops

- ✓ Political will is essential.
- ✓ Establishing relationship and credibility (sharing role, building trust)
- ✓ Funding
- ✓ Win win situations
- ✓ Importance of building and maintaining trust (building relationships from the ground up; engaging community; sharing power; finding common goals)
- ✓ HiAP framework requires different levels of trust





#### **Day Two**

#### Issues of governance

- ✓ Barriers tied up with politics
- ✓ Political conflicts impacting HiAP implementation
- ✓ A win-win strategy to help engage diverse sectors into HiAP (developing a shared language; using tools such as HIA; using scientific evidence for credibility)

#### Examples related to HiAP

- ✓ A win-win approach is important
- ✓ A holistic vision of health (idea of well-being and happiness)
- ✓ The Four Pillars of Gross National Happiness (sustainable and equitable socio-economic development; preservation and promotion of culture; conservation of the environment; good governance)
- ✓ The importance of local level (the level where people live and where actions need to happen)
